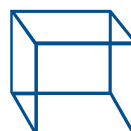
Timetable

Fastway Courier Franchisees carry timetables which outline the daily cut off times in your location. Ask your courier for their timetables so you can be sure to have your parcels ready for pick up on time.



Re-ordering

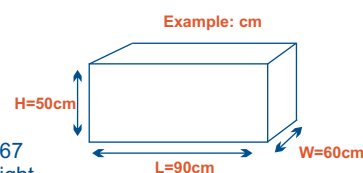
Each Fastway Courier Franchisee keeps stocks of prepaid labels and satchels with them at all times. Let your courier know when you would like to purchase. An invoice will be written and the labels or satchels provided on receipt of payment.



Cubing Guide

Courier parcels are charged at the cubic weight, or the dead weight, whichever is the greater. The cubic conversion rate is 167kg per cubic metre. You can calculate the cubic weight of a parcel by following these simple instructions.

- Convert measurements to metres.
For example
 $H = .50, W = .60, L = .90$
- Multiply the length x width x height X 167
(Cubic conversion rate) to get cubic weight.
- If the actual weight of this parcel was 25kgs, and the cubic weight was 45kgs, 'the charge will apply to which ever is the greater'.



Parcels with a cubic weight greater than 30kgs may be carried 'at our discretion' but if carried they will require an extra label for each 30kgs or part thereof.
